FIRE DEPT. & AMBULANCE:

CLEAN ENERGY, NYSEDA GRANT STATUS, ETC.: grant stipulations are still being

Discussion was held regarding the car-charging station...DEC had originally
offered grants for these stations, but have reversed their policy..
hopefully grant program will be restored.

WATER: usage is up so it appears that a leak is in existence.
Rural Water Assoc. representative will help locate it.

FUEL OIL BIDS: Clerk authorized to advertise for bids for possible
